Wave Streetcar Project  
Proposed Street Median Changes  
Broward County, Florida

On behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Four, you and your staff are invited to a Public Hearing regarding proposed street median changes for the above referenced project. The proposed changes are to construct a median station platform along South Andrews Avenue at the intersection of SW/SE 13 Street, and concrete medians at the intersections of Rose Drive, SW/SE 11 Court, SW/SE 10 Street, and SW/SE 8 Street. These changes would prevent vehicles from making a left turn into or out of the side streets. A streetcar median station platform is proposed on NW 1 Avenue (Brickell Avenue) between Broward Boulevard and NW 2 Street which will prevent vehicles from making a left turn within that block. The proposed median change at the intersection of South Andrews Avenue and SW/SE 14 Street will allow vehicles to make a left turn from South Andrews Avenue, but vehicles on SW 14 Street and SE 14 Street will only be able to make a right turn on South Andrews Avenue.

The Public Hearing will be held on **Wednesday, January 18, 2017, starting at 5:30 p.m., at the United Way of Broward County, Ansin Building, located at 1300 South Andrews Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33316.** The Public Hearing will be conducted as an informal open house, with a formal presentation starting at 6:00 p.m., followed by a comment period. Persons wishing to submit written statements or other exhibits, in place of or in addition to oral statements, may do so at the hearing or by sending them to Robert E. Bostian, Jr., PE, FDOT Project Manager, 3400 West Commercial Boulevard, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33309. All exhibits or statements postmarked on or before Saturday, January 28, 2017, will become part of the Public Hearing record.
