Mission Statement

The City of Fort Lauderdale's Green Team strives to accelerate City efforts to achieve the internal sustainability goals of Press Play and the Sustainability Action Plan.

Project 1

Reduce energy consumption by turning off computer monitors and room lights when not in use.



Monitors Surveyed: 250

- ✓ Average reduction: 36%
- ✓ Biggest reduction: 68%
- ✓ 6 areas recorded 100% off

Rooms Surveyed: 217

- ✓ Average reduction: 28%
- ✓ Biggest reduction: 98%
- √ 7 areas recorded 100% off


Project 2

To reduce waste generated and increase recycling volumes in City facilities.



Statistics

- Decreased waste generated in all areas
- ✓ Overall waste generation decreased by 55%, eliminating 183 tons of solid waste per year
- ✓ Increased recycling volumes in 70% of areas
- ✓ Increase in recycling would fill 250 MORE blue carts over a year
- ✓ Waste contamination decreased by 75%



Purpose

To encourage sustainable practices among city staff in the use and purchase of paper products

May 30, 2017 – July 21, 2017

Paper Waste & Consumption Facts

- Every year, 1 billion trees worth of paper are thrown away in the U.S.
- Americans use 85 million tons of paper a year equivalent to 680 pounds per person.
- An average American uses 465 trees worth of paper during their lifetime.
- The amount of wood and paper we throw away each year is enough to heat 50 million homes for 20 years.
- Every ton of office paper recycled can save the energy equivalent of 322 gallons of gasoline consumed.

Goal

- To reduce paper products usage;
- Increase purchase of sustainable paper products; and
- To increase awareness of the Sustainability Purchasing Policy.

Champion Responsibilities – Pre-Challenge

- Register area
- Determine number of participating workstations
 - Areas with shared copiers/printers may have to form one team
- Complete tracking forms for
 - Printer/Copier inventory
 - Copy paper inventory
- Complete copier/printer paper usage audit to determine baseline
- Identify community builder/s responsible for procurement of office supplies

Champion Responsibilities – During Challenge

- Report bi-weekly copier/printer paper usage
- Report tracking information for
 - number who signed green pledge;
 - number with eco email message; and
 - at least one sustainable product purchased with recyclable content and attributes.
- Share educational materials and visual aids
- Distribute stickers & engage participants through creative strategies
- Attend 3 Green Team Meetings (May, June, & July)
