

EVERY DAY IS A MEDICATION TAKE-BACK DAY IN FORT LAUDERDALE

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department (FLPD) has installed a secure collection box for unused, unwanted, or expired prescription and non-prescription medications in the lobby of the Police Department. Residents and visitors may drop off medications any time between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. seven days a week.

By properly and safely disposing of medications you can help:

- Prevent prescription drug abuse,
- Prevent accidental overdoses,
- Prevent accidental poisoning of children and pets,
- Reduce crime by keeping prescription medications from ending up on our streets,
- Reduce environmental pollution,
- Decrease the amount of waste sent to local landfills, and
- Protect our drinking water supply, local waterways and native wildlife.
