Riverwalk, in partnership with the City of Fort Lauderdale, will formally dedicate the Riverwalk 9-11 Monument to honor all those who lost their lives in the terrorist attacks and commemorate the ultimate sacrifices made by our first responders.

The Riverwalk 9-11 Monument displays a rail segment from the tracks of the PATH (Port Authority Trans-Hudson) rapid transit station that was located at the World Trade Center. After picking up the last passengers on September 11, 2001 at 9:10 a.m., the station was left empty and buried under the rubble of the collapsed towers. The monument displays the rail in an uplifted position supported by granite pillars, which symbolize the solid bedrock of Manhattan that supports its massive buildings.
