

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

Wave Modern Streetcar Supplemental Environmental Assessment S Andrews Avenue/E 3rd Avenue between S 17th Street and NE 6th Street City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida

The South Florida Regional Transportation Authority (SFRTA) will conduct a Public Hearing for the proposed Wave Modern Streetcar in the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida. The Public Hearing will be held on Wednesday, April 29, 2015 at the City of Fort Lauderdale City Hall, 100 N. Andrews Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301. The Public Hearing will begin as an open house at 6 p.m. with a formal presentation at 6:15 p.m., followed by a public comment period. The proposed improvement involves the Wave Modern Streetcar which would extend approximately 2.8 miles from S 17th Street and S Andrews Avenue, adjacent to Broward General Medical Center, running north to NE 6th Street and NE 3rd Avenue. The north-south alignment of the project would primarily be along Andrews Avenue, Brickell Avenue and E 3rd Avenue.

This Public Hearing is being conducted to give interested persons an opportunity to express their views concerning the location, conceptual design, and social, economic, and environmental effects of the proposed improvements and in accordance with Federal Executive Orders 11990 and 11988. The project consists of the construction of a new streetcar system in Downtown Fort Lauderdale.

The draft project documents and other information will be available for public review beginning Wednesday, April 8 through Monday, May 11, at the Broward County Main Library at 100 S Andrews Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301 on Mondays, Thursdays and Fridays from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. and on Tuesdays and Wednesdays from noon to 8 p.m.; and also at the City of Fort Lauderdale Transportation & Mobility Building, 290 NE 3rd Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301 weekdays between the hours of 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. Persons wishing to submit written statements or other exhibits, in place of or in addition to oral statements, may do so at the Public Hearing or by sending them to the SFRTA Project Manager, Barbara Handrahan, at 800 NW 33rd Street, Pompano Beach, Florida 33064 or by email at handrahanb@sfirta.fl.gov. All exhibits or statements postmarked on or before Monday, May 11 will become a part of the Public Hearing record.
